

Explanation of estimates for tuition and fees:

Tuition rates are based on the nonresident rate plus mandatory fees. Special program, laboratory, and course-specific fees are not included.

Actual expenses will vary depending upon program and number of credit hours taken per semester.

For specific program fees, go to <http://bursar.iupui.edu/apps/costestimator.aspx>. Your academic program advisor can verify the number of credit hours required by your program for full-time status. Tuition increases are approved annually in late spring and may range from 3-5%. Summer enrollment is not required for many programs so is not included in the estimated expenses.*

Mandatory Fees for one year equal \$1362.00 and include the IUPUI General Fee (\$781), Repair and Rehabilitation Fee (\$339.60), Placement Test Fee (\$50, one-time charge), and International Services Fee (\$190.80).

Actual costs will depend on your personal choices and spending habits. Housing costs will vary depending on where you live. Eating meals in restaurants will significantly increase the cost of food each month. The information above is based on the average cost of campus housing with a full meal plan.

Dependents:

If you plan to bring your spouse and/or dependent children with you, you must document funding for each dependent to cover the cost of basic needs like rent, food, clothing, and health insurance:

- Spouse: \$6,974
- 1 Child: \$6,974
- 2 Children: \$13,948
- For additional children beyond 2, you will only need to show \$5,175 per child
